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(Pocket-lint) - If party-game is what you crave, Nintendo consoles have always been the best choice. The Wii has captured the public imagination thanks to its batch of gaming capabilities and, if anything, the Switch (at least on paper) has even better batch of gaming credentials, thanks to its extra portability. So it's a little surprising that Nintendo took so long to bring its longtime game franchise, Mario Party, to the Switch. Was it worth the wait? At least the Super Mario Party got enough revamp compared to its predecessors to deserve a Super Prefix. While he remains comfortingly familiar to those who have played Mario party games in the past, he's also sporting some distinctly innovative elements - and innovation isn't what the franchise used to be known for. The central element of Super Mario Party is quite familiar: it is a virtual tincture in which four players compete to win stars and coins. You can choose the length of the game from 10 to 20 turns (the first takes about an hour). For the Super Mario Party, the head game section has got a reasonable set of tweaks - every Nintendo character you play, how you can choose to use your own special Die, which, for example, can allow you to throw numbers as high as six, but will add to the risk of not making progress at all. Four boards are packed with way of permutations of incidents, bonuses, hidden blocks and the ability to steal star opponents and coins. Ally spaces come in particularly handy, as they bring buddies whose dice throws to increase yours. Super Mario Party has gone way more on mini-games than its predecessors: while most of them pit four players against each other (the game will streak into AI players if less than four people play), there are also plenty that deftly pit three players against one, as well as 2v2 team mini-games. NintendoThe mini-games aren't as weird as those of WarioWare games, but sometimes they come close - most are stupid enough to bring in at least a smile, and most of them use Joy-Con controller motion sensing and even drone abilities. You may have to whirl around as if pedals to win a children's tricycle race, wave it around to remove the virtual Out of the jar, or own it as a pan handle, flipping the beef cube until it is cooked on all six sides. The best game switch every player has to own you can jump in Play any mini-games that take your fancy, or engage in some more structured mini-game exercises. Marioton, for example, pits contestants against each other in a sequence of five mini-games. Square Off centers on 4x4 grids and throws 16 mini-games at you; The winner of each gets the color squared, and if you can attach any of the squares to your opponents, you'll get to steal them. Sound Stage bands sequence music based on mini-games together. The most innovative section of Super Mario Party is Toad's Rec Room, where you'll find a number of games designed to play using two connected Switch consoles. There's a queue pattern matching the game, which involves targeting two consoles, so you align both ends of the bananas that have been split in two, but most of the toad's Rec Room games pit two teams of two, with a switch each, against each other. Again, the classic party fare. NintendoThere is also a long four-player co-operative game called River Survival, which puts you in a raft that you have to get to the end of the river before time passes. This includes padding in sync with your teammates, hitting accelerations and balloons that cause mini-games that bring renewal time. Being able to choose different paths along the river brings outrun-style flavor and adds a lot of snooze value. Like its predecessors, the Super Mario Party doesn't bother with any coherent structure, but it does provide plenty of incentive to explore it every corner. The more you play, the more mini-games you unlock, and further rewards await when you unlock them all. You earn in-game currency that can be spent on items such as stickers, and when you work your way through all of any of the elements of the game, you start earning gems that also lead to rewards. NintendoPlus you can play Marioton against online opponents, which is the first to play Mario Party, although it requires a Nintendo Online subscription, which seems a bit cheeky. The Verdict Super Mario Party is by no means one of the most important switch games: the franchise is always focused on providing fun, frothy party games to engage with when you return from the pub, perhaps, or at Christmas family gatherings. If that's what you're looking for, however, you'll find it very satisfying. This is by far the best game Mario party has ever made, and committed Nintendo fans will find it irresistible.
